INTRODUCTION

The Courtyard by Marriott at New Mexico State University (NMSU) opened in July 2019 and is estimated to have a total hotel revenue of \$4,524,995 for the year of 2021. The hotel currently employs 46 associates, to include eight active NMSU students, four of which are NMSU HRTM students, and five are NMSU HRTM Alumni.
